**SUBJECT: PERSONNEL SELECTION, TRAINING, QUALIFICATION AND
CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DOE NUCLEAR FACILITIES**

1. EXPLANATION OF CHANGES. Corrects an erroneous paragraph break that misapplied criteria for training of certain personnel. This applies only to staff members at Hazard Category 1/ Category A Reactor Facilities
